POLICE SEEK PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE WITH INFORMATION REGARDING A SHOOTING THAT OCCURRED MAY 24, 2020

SUFFOLK, VA (June 26, 2020) The Suffolk Police Department is seeking the public's assistance with information in regards to a shooting that occurred on May 24, 2020, at Renee's Celebration Center, located in the 100 block of E. Washington Street, for which a Media Release was previously provided.

On Monday, May 24, 2020, at 11:48 p.m., Suffolk Police Emergency Communications received a call in regards to a shooting that had occurred in the parking lot. Upon preliminary investigation, it was determined that an adult female had been shot in the lower torso and was transported to a local hospital for treatment. An adult male subject was charged with a weapons violation and was cooperative during the investigation. Detectives are continuing to investigate and following any leads provided.
