ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (July 14, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, July 14, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road between Eclipse Drive and Townpoint Road from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Sleepy Hole Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Sleepy Hole Road between Nansemond Parkway and Kings Highway from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Kensington Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Kensington Boulevard between Godwin Boulevard and Jester Circle from 10:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

(Finney Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have a lane closure in the 100 block of Finney Avenue for utility work from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(various locations) – A contractor will be working on the following roads: Dutch Road, Glen Haven Drive, Cumberland Lane, Buckhorn Drive, Chappell Drive, and Kingsale Road for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Godwin Boulevard between North Main Street and the Isle of Wight County line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Bank Street Extended) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Bank Street Extended between North Capital Street and North 4th Street for a paving operation from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(various locations) – A contractor will have mobile shoulder closures along the detour route for the upcoming Wilroy Road bridge closure, July 13 through July 17.

(Kings Highway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Kings Highway between Godwin Boulevard and the dead end for vegetation maintenance from 12 p.m. to 6 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Manning Road, Manning Bridge Road, Rountree Crescent, Cypress Chapel, Glen Haven Drive, Barnes Road, Lake Cahoon Road, Harvest Drive, Bennetts Pasture Road, Lee Farm lane, and Indian Trail for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Holy Neck Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 6000 block of Holy Neck Road for drainage maintenance from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Armstead Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Armstead Road for vegetation maintenance from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Shoulders Hill Road) – A contractor will have a permanent shoulder closure in the 3300 block of Shoulders Hill Road from July 15 through July 27.

(Wilroy Road) – A contractor will have Wilroy Road closed in both directions between River Creek Drive and Lassiter Lane beginning Monday, July 20, 2020. The closure is necessary to demolish the existing deficient culvert and build a new bridge on Wilroy Road. This will provide a safe and long-term solution to the current culvert and shoulder. The road will be closed with a detour in place until mid-late November 2020.

Ongoing Projects:

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bellflower Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 20 through July 30.

(Route 58/Holland Road) – A contractor will have crews working eastbound on Route 58/Holland Road beyond the shoulder between Manning Road and Staley Drive from 6:30 a.m. to 6 p.m., Tuesday through Friday, July 14 through July 17.

(Hill Street) – A contractor will have the 300 block of Hill Street closed with a detour from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(North 4th Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 200 block of North 4th Street closed with a detour for drainage upgrades from 7 a.m. to 2 p.m. until July 31.

(Hunter Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 200 block of Hunter Street closed with a detour for drainage upgrades from 7 a.m. to 2 p.m. until July 31.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through July 31.

(Blythewood Lane) – A contractor will have the 1100 block of Blythewood Lane closed to through traffic for a sewer line installation from May 11 through July 20.

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
