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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (July 16, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, July 16, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road between Eclipse Drive and Townpoint Drive from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Godwin Boulevard between the Reids Ferry Bridge and North Main Street for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Little Fork Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Little Fork Road between Whaleyville Boulevard and Great Fork Road closed with a detour for drainage maintenance from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Armstead Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Armstead Road for vegetation maintenance from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Shoulders Hill Road, Knotts Neck Road, College Drive, Great Fork Road, Indian Trail, Buckhorn Drive, and Ashburn Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Dill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have a lane closure in the 100 block of Dill Road for utility work from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Jackson Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Jackson Road at Turlington Road from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Sign and Paint Crew will have a right lane closure on Route 58 westbound from Route 272 to the Southampton County line from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound mobile operation on Route 58 between Godwin Boulevard and the Route 13/32 Bypass interchange for vegetation maintenance from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.

(Holland Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 1100 block of Holland Road on the bridge over Lake Meade for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Pitchkettle Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Pitchkettle Road on the bridge over Lake Meade for vegetation maintenance from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Wilroy Road) – A contractor will have Wilroy Road closed in both directions between River Creek Drive and Lassiter Lane beginning Monday, July 20, 2020. The closure is necessary to demolish the existing deficient culvert and build a new bridge on Wilroy Road. This will provide a safe and long-term solution to the current culvert and shoulder. The road will be closed with a detour in place until mid-late November 2020.

Ongoing Projects:

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bellflower Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 20 through July 30.

(various locations) – A contractor will have mobile shoulder closures along the detour route for the upcoming Wilroy Road bridge closure, July 13 through July 17.

(Sleepy Hole Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Sleepy Hole Road between Nansemond Parkway and Kings Highway from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., July 14 through July 18.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – A contractor will have a permanent shoulder closure in the 3300 block of Shoulders Hill Road from July 15 through July 27.

(various locations) – A contractor will be working on the following roads: Dutch Road, Glen Haven Drive, Cumberland Lane, Buckhorn Drive, Chappell Drive, and Kingsale Road for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., July 13 through July 17.

(Route 58/Holland Road) – A contractor will have crews working eastbound on Route 58/Holland Road beyond the shoulder between Manning Road and Staley Drive from 6:30 a.m. to 6 p.m., Tuesday through Friday, July 14 through July 17.

(Hill Street) – A contractor will have the 300 block of Hill Street closed with a detour from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(North 4th Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 200 block of North 4th Street closed with a detour for drainage upgrades from 7 a.m. to 2 p.m. until July 31.

(Hunter Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 200 block of Hunter Street closed with a detour for drainage upgrades from 7 a.m. to 2 p.m. until July 31.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through July 31.

(Blythewood Lane) – A contractor will have the 1100 block of Blythewood Lane closed to through traffic for a sewer line installation from May 11 through July 20.

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
