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### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (July 21, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, July 21, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

**New Projects:**

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road between Eclipse Drive and Townpoint Road from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(South Quay Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on South Quay Road between Dutch Road and Route 58 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Pineview Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 8000 block of Pineview Road for drainage maintenance from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Lake Prince Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Lake Prince Drive for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations at the following locations from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for vegetation maintenance: Old Myrtle Road, Old Mill Road, Pitchkettle Road, Murphys Mill Road, Crittenden Road and Ferry Point Road.

(Weatherby Way) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Weatherby Way at Shoulders Hill Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Portsmouth Boulevard and Beamon Mill Trail for drainage maintenance from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(various locations) – A contractor will be working in the Mt. Horeb Neighborhood, Bank Street and Liberty Street for vegetation maintenance from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have eastbound and westbound mobile operations on Route 58 between Godwin Boulevard and the Route 13/32 Bypass interchange for vegetation maintenance from 8:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a northbound right lane closure in the 3800 block of Bridge Road overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

(Jackson Road and Turlington Road) – A contractor will have flagging operations on Jackson Road and Turlington Road at the intersection from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

**Upcoming Projects:**

(South Main Street) – Beginning Monday, August 10, a contractor will have South Main Street closed with a detour for a railroad crossing replacement, August 10 through August 14. Message boards will be placed in the area on August 3, 2020.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bellflower Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 20 through July 30.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on College Drive at Lake View Parkway from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., July 20 through July 21.

(various locations) – A contractor will be working on the following roads for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., July 20 through July 24: South Quay Road, Ruritan Boulevard, Holland Road and East Glen Haven Drive.

(Sleepy Hole Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Sleepy Hole Road between Nansemond Parkway and Kings Highway from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., July 14 through July 21.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – A contractor will have a permanent shoulder closure in the 3300 block of Shoulders Hill Road from July 15 through July 27.

(Hill Street) – A contractor will have the 300 block of Hill Street closed with a detour from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., July 20 through July 24.

(Wilroy Road) – A contractor will have Wilroy Road closed in both directions between River Creek Drive and Lassiter Lane beginning Monday, July 20, 2020. The closure is necessary to demolish the existing deficient culvert and build a new bridge on Wilroy Road. This will provide a safe and long-term solution to the current culvert and shoulder. The road will be closed with a detour in place until mid-late November 2020.

(North 4<sup>th</sup> Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working in the 100 block of North 4<sup>th</sup> Street for drainage upgrades from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. until July 31.

(Hunter Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 300 block of Hunter Street closed with a detour for drainage upgrades from 7 a.m. to 2 p.m. until July 31.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through July 31.

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
