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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (July 24, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, July 24, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(East Washington Street) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 1100 block of East Washington Street from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Sleepy Hole Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Sleepy Hole Road between Nansemond Parkway and Kings Highway from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Whaleyville Boulevard between the NC state line and Carolina Road for asphalt maintenance from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have eastbound and westbound mobile operations on Route 58 between the Route 13/32 Bypass interchange and the six lanes for vegetation maintenance from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. The contractor will be mowing

between Wilroy Road and the six lanes and weed eating between Pitchkettle Road and the 13/32 Bypass.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 2900 block of Carolina Road for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound ramp narrowing on Route 58 at the off-ramp for the Route 13/32 Southern Bypass for guardrail repairs from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound left shoulder closure on Route 58 at the SPSA crossover for guardrail repairs from 12 p.m. to 4 p.m.

(Wilroy Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation northbound on Wilroy Road at QVC Drive for paving from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m., July 23 and July 24.

Upcoming Projects:

(South Main Street) – Beginning Monday, August 10, a contractor will have South Main Street closed with a detour for a railroad crossing replacement, August 10 through August 14. Message boards will be placed in the area on August 3, 2020.

(Bridge Road)- Beginning Saturday, July 25, a contractor will have a southbound right lane closure in the 3800 block of Bridge Road from 6 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bellflower Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 20 through July 30.

(Various Locations) – A contractor will be working on the following roads for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., July 20 through July 24: South Quay Road, Ruritan Boulevard, Holland Road, and East Glen Haven Drive.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – A contractor will have a permanent shoulder closure in the 3300 block of Shoulders Hill Road from July 15 through July 27.

(Hill Street) – A contractor will have the 300 block of Hill Street closed with a detour from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., July 20 through July 24.

(Wilroy Road) – A contractor will have Wilroy Road closed in both directions between River Creek Drive and Lassiter Lane beginning Monday, July 20, 2020. The closure is necessary to demolish the existing deficient culvert and build a new bridge on Wilroy Road. This will provide a safe and long-term solution to the current culvert and shoulder. The road will be closed with a detour in place until mid-late November 2020.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through July 31.

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
