POLICE SEEK PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE IDENTIFYING MAN IN CREDIT CARD FRAUD INCIDENTS

SUFFOLK, VA (July 27, 2020) - The Suffolk Police Department is seeking the public's assistance in identifying a male subject wanted for alleged connections in some recent thefts from motor vehicles and also credit card frauds in Suffolk.

The victim reported that the windows were broken out of her vehicle while in a parking lot in the 4800 block of Townpoint Road on Friday, July 10, 2020, in the area of the Suffolk Seaboard Coastline Trail in Northern Suffolk. The victim's purse, containing credit cards, was stolen out of the vehicle. Within two hours, the victim's credit cards were used at two different locations (once in Suffolk and once in Portsmouth), totaling over \$1,500.00. Attached are photographs from one of the store's security cameras.
