FIREFIGHTERS RESPOND TO RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE FIRE

SUFFOLK, VA (July 30, 2020) Suffolk Fire & Rescue units responded earlier this morning, Thursday, July 30th, to a residential structure fire in the 3000 block of Woodlawn Drive.

Emergency Communications was contacted at 9:21 a.m. and the first unit arrived on scene in the Idlewood neighborhood at 9:28 a.m.

Battalion Chief Demitri Wilson advised that first arriving fire units found light smoke showing from an electrical panel in the single story residence. The fire was out upon arrival and damage was isolated to the electrical panel in the garage.

Two adults have been displaced. There were no injuries. The fire was called under control at 10:12 a.m.

Responding units included Battalion 1, Engines 6, 26, and 1, Ladder 6, Medic 6, Rescue 1, EMS1, Safety 1, and Tankers 1 and 7.
