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### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (July 31, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, July 31, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

**New Projects:**

(Route 58) – A contractor will have eastbound returning westbound mobile operations on Route 58 between Godwin Boulevard and the Chesapeake City line for vegetation maintenance from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – A contractor will have a lane shift on Shoulder Hill Road at Pughsville Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Everets Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Everets Road at Audobon Road from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on College Drive at Harbourview Boulevard from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 3900 block of Pughsville Road for an emergency repair from 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Kenyon Road) – A contractor will have a lane shift on Kenyon Road from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Old Mill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Old Mill Road between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail for drainage maintenance from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Gates Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 9200 block of Gates Road for drainage maintenance from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working in the median of the 3800 block of Bridge Road for drainage maintenance from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Various) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Holy Neck Road, Ellis Road and Southwestern Boulevard for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

### **Upcoming Projects:**

(South Main Street) – Beginning Monday, August 10, a contractor will have South Main Street closed with a detour for a railroad crossing replacement, August 10 through August 14. Message boards will be placed in the area on August 3, 2020.

(Route 13/32) – A contractor will have a lane closure on the Route 13/32 Bypass over Lake Kilby for a bridge inspection from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 5 and 6.

(Pinner Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pinner Street for a bridge inspection from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 10.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Bridge Road over Bennetts Creek for a bridge inspection from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 11 and 12.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have an inside lane closure on Harbour View Boulevard between Harbour Point Drive and River Club Drive from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 3 and 4.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have an outside lane closure on Harbour View Boulevard between Harbour Point Drive and River Club Drive from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 5 and 6.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have a right lane closure in the 1200 block of Holland Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 3 through August 7.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Godwin Boulevard at the Reids Ferry bridge for a bridge inspection from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 13.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile lane closure on Bridge Road over Bennetts Creek for bridge inspections from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m., August 14.

(Route 13/32) – A contractor will have a lane closure on the Route 13/32 Bypass over Lake Kilby for a bridge inspection from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m., August 14.

## **Ongoing Projects:**

(Hunter Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 200 block of Hunter Street closed with a detour for drainage upgrades from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North 4th Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 100 block of North 4th Street closed with a detour for drainage upgrades from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Wilroy Road) – A contractor will have Wilroy Road closed in both directions between River Creek Drive and Lassiter Lane beginning Monday, July 20, 2020. The closure is necessary to demolish the existing deficient culvert and build a new bridge on Wilroy Road. This will provide a safe and long-term solution to the current culvert and shoulder. The road will be closed with a detour in place until mid-late November 2020.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through July 31.

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
