**UPDATE**

SUFFOLK, VA (August 3, 2020) Suffolk Fire & Rescue Station 4, located at 837 Lake Kilby Road, which has been closed effective June 3, 2020, for work on the engine bay, will temporarily reopen in advance of Hurricane Isaias this evening, Monday, August 3, 2020, at 8:00 p.m., equipped with Engine 4 and accompanying staff in advance of any potential impacts of Hurricane Isaias.

Following this emergency weather event, the status moving forward of the building and ongoing repairs will be reevaluated.

**UPDATE**

SUFFOLK, VA (June 24, 2020) Suffolk Fire & Rescue Station 4, located at 837 Lake Kilby Road, which has been closed effective June 3, 2020, for work on the engine bay doors, will remain closed until further notice so that the required work can be completed.

Staff and equipment will remain temporarily reassigned to Station 6, 300 Kings Fork Road, while the repairs continue.

Signage remains on the doors at Station 4 to alert the public to call 9-1-1 in case of emergency, and to call Station 6 for non-emergencies at 514-4550.

## **REPAIRS SCHEDULED FOR SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE STATION 4**

SUFFOLK, VA (May 27, 2020) Suffolk Fire & Rescue Station 4, located at 837 Lake Kilby Road, will be closed for work on the engine bay doors effective Wednesday, June 3, 2020.

Staff and equipment will be temporarily reassigned to Station 6, 300 Kings Fork Road, while repairs are taking place. Due to the nature and extent of the required work and the dependence on weather conditions, the closure and reassignment is expected to take approximately 3 weeks for completion.

Signage will be placed on the doors at Station 4 to alert the public to call 9-1-1 in case of emergency, and to call Station 6 for non-emergencies at 514-4550.
