### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (August 6, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, August 6, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

**New Projects:**

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound mobile operation on Route 58 between Wilroy Road and Godwin Boulevard for vegetation maintenance from 8:30 a.m. to 10 a.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road from College Drive to the Isle of Wight line for vegetation maintenance from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on College Drive for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m.

(Route 13/32 Bypass) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on the Route 13/32 Bypass for vegetation maintenance from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Sign Crew will have a westbound right lane closure on Route 58 between Holy Neck Road and the Southampton County line from 8:30 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on eastbound and westbound Route 58 for debris pickup from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Whaleyville Boulevard between Collins Road and the North Carolina state line for vegetation debris cleanup from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have an inside lane closure on Harbour View Boulevard between Harbour Point Drive and River Club Drive from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road between Eclipse Drive and Townpoint Road from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have a right lane closure in the 1200 block of Holland Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 3 through August 7.

(William Reid Drive) – A contractor will have a lane closure on William Reid Drive from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 3 through August 7.

**Upcoming Projects:**

(South Main Street) – Beginning Monday, August 10, Norfolk Southern will have South Main Street closed with a detour for a railroad crossing replacement, August 10 through August 15. Message boards were placed in the area on August 4, 2020.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Bridge Road over Bennetts Creek for a bridge inspection from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 11 and August 12.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have an outside lane closure on Harbour View Boulevard between Harbour Point Drive and River Club Drive from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 7.

(William Reid Drive) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Godwin Boulevard and William Reid Drive for milling and paving from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., August 8.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Godwin Boulevard at the Reids Ferry Bridge for a bridge inspection from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 10.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile lane closure on Bridge Road over Bennetts Creek for bridge inspections from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m., August 14.

(Route 13/32 Bypass) – A contractor will have a lane closure on the Route 13/32 Bypass over Lake Kilby for a bridge inspection from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m., August 14.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(Wilroy Road) – A contractor will have Wilroy Road closed in both directions between River Creek Drive and Lassiter Lane beginning Monday, July 20, 2020. The closure is necessary to demolish the existing deficient culvert and build a new bridge on Wilroy Road. This will provide a safe and long-term solution to the current culvert and shoulder. The road will be closed with a detour in place until mid-late November 2020.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a lane shift on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bellflower Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 20 through August 7.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through August 31.
