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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (August 7, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, August 7, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(County Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have County Street closed between Mill Street and Hunter Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road from College Drive to the Isle of Wight line for vegetation maintenance from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Route 13/32 Bypass) – A contractor will have mobile operations on the Route 13/32 Bypass for vegetation maintenance from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Kings Fork Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have the center lane closed on Kings Fork Road at Indian Point Road from 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have an inside lane closure on Harbour View Boulevard between Harbour Point Drive and River Club Drive from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have a right lane closure in the 1200 block of Holland Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 3 through August 7.

(William Reid Drive) – A contractor will have a lane closure on William Reid Drive from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 3 through August 7.

Upcoming Projects:

(South Main Street) – Beginning Monday, August 10, Norfolk Southern will have South Main Street closed with a detour for a railroad crossing replacement, August 10 through August 15. Message boards were placed in the area on August 4, 2020.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Bridge Road over Bennetts Creek for a bridge inspection from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 11 and August 12.

(Godwin Boulevard and William Reid Drive) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Godwin Boulevard and William Reid Drive for milling and paving from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., August 8.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have the turn lane on Bridge Road closed to Windward Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., August 10.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have the turn lane on Bridge Road closed to Harbour Breeze from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., August 10.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Godwin Boulevard at the Reids Ferry Bridge for a bridge inspection from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 10.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have an outside lane closure southbound on Harbour View Boulevard between Harbour Point Drive and River Club Drive from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 10 and August 11.

(Everets Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Everets Road between Audubon Road and Godwin Boulevard from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 10 through August 14.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile lane closure on Bridge Road over Bennetts Creek for bridge inspections from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m., August 14.

(Route 13/32 Bypass) – A contractor will have a lane closure on the Route 13/32 Bypass over Lake Kilby for a bridge inspection from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m., August 14.

Ongoing Projects:

(Wilroy Road) – A contractor will have Wilroy Road closed in both directions between River Creek Drive and Lassiter Lane beginning Monday, July 20, 2020. The closure is necessary to demolish the existing deficient culvert and build a new bridge on Wilroy Road. This will provide a safe and long-term solution to the current culvert and shoulder. The road will be closed with a detour in place until mid-late November 2020.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – A contractor will have a lane shift on Shoulders Hill Road at Pughsville Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., August 6 and August 7.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through August 31.

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
