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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (August 26, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, August 26, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound mobile operation on Route 58 between the Chesapeake City line and the Route 10/32 Interchange for vegetation maintenance from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a northbound mobile operation on Carolina Road between the North Carolina State line and Whaleyville Boulevard merge for vegetation maintenance from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on College Drive between Bridge Road and Armstead Road for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road between College Drive and the Isle of Wight line for vegetation maintenance from 12 p.m. to 5 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Day Farm Lane and Bennetts Pasture Road for pavement marking installation from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Sleepy Hole Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Sleepy Hole Road between Nansemond Parkway and Kings Highway for pavement marking installation from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have crews working in the 1500 and 1900 blocks of Holland Road from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., August 21 through August 28.

(Linden Avenue) – A contractor will have Linden Avenue closed with a detour from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., August 24 through August 26.

(White Marsh Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on White Marsh Road between Cypress Chapel Road and Carolina Road for milling from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Indian Trail) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Indian Trail between Kingsdale Road and Ruritan Boulevard for paving from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., August 25 through August 27.

(Pembroke Lane) – A contractor will be working on the shoulder of Pembroke Lane at Godwin Boulevard for drainage maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Hunter Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 200 block of Hunter Street closed with a detour for drainage upgrades from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m., August 25 through August 28.

(North 4th Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 100 block of North 4th Street closed with a detour for drainage upgrades from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m., August 25 through August 28.

(Turlington Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Turlington Road at the Route 13/32 off ramp for guardrail repairs from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Carolina Road between the Whaleyville Boulevard merge and the Route 13/32 Bypass for herbicide application from 8:30 a.m. to 12 pm.

(Bridge Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have northbound mobile lane closures on Bridge Road between College Drive and Bennetts Pasture Road for pavement marking from 10 p.m. to 4 a.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Pruden Boulevard at Old Myrtle Road from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 25 and August 26.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Lee Farm Lane, Freeman Mill Road, Mineral Spring Road, Sleepy Hole Road, Pitchkettle Road, Lake Cahoon Road, and Old Mill Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(South Main Street) – A contractor will have South Main Street closed with a detour for a railroad crossing replacement. Message boards will be placed ahead of the start date which is to be determined.

Ongoing Projects:

(Wilroy Road) – A contractor will have Wilroy Road closed in both directions between River Creek Drive and Lassiter Lane beginning Monday, July 20, 2020. The closure is necessary to demolish the existing deficient culvert and build a new bridge on Wilroy Road. This will provide a safe and long-term solution to the current culvert and shoulder. The road will be closed with a detour in place until mid-late November 2020.

(South Saratoga Street) - South Saratoga Street is closed to thru traffic between Jackson Street and West Washington Street.

(Saratoga Street) – Saratoga Street is closed to thru traffic between Market Street and Washington Street. Businesses are open.

(West Washington Street) - West Washington Street at Saratoga Street is closed to thru traffic. Businesses are open.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through August 31.

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
