### **POLICE SEEK PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE IDENTIFYING MAN WANTED FOR CREDIT CARD FRAUD**

SUFFOLK, VA (September 3, 2020) - The Suffolk Police Department is seeking the public's assistance in identifying a male subject wanted for alleged connections in some recent thefts from motor vehicles and also credit card frauds which took place throughout Hampton Roads.

The victim reported that on July 30, 2020, his vehicle was rummaged through while it was parked in a parking lot in the 5900-block of Harbour View Boulevard in Suffolk. The victim advised that several items were stolen out of his vehicle, to include his credit cards. He was later alerted by his bank of his credit cards being used in different locations in Portsmouth and Virginia Beach, totaling over \$1,700.00.
