## **UPDATE**

SUFFOLK, VA (September 4, 2020) Suffolk Police advise that following positive identification and making notifications to next of kin, the victims in the industrial accident that occurred on Saturday, August 29, 2020, have been identified as Salvador Jovel Serrano, age 32, of the Republic of Honduras; and Jose Roberto Cuevas-Macias, age 34, of Mexico.

The investigation remains ongoing at this time and there is no further information available for release.

## **UPDATE**

SUFFOLK, VA (August 29, 2020) Suffolk Fire & Rescue along with Chesapeake and Virginia Beach Technical Rescue Teams completed the primary search of the scene with no additional victims located. All other workers at the job site have been accounted for and no additional injuries were reported.

The names of the deceased are being withheld at this time pending notification of next of kin.

The incident remains under investigation.

## **SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE AND SUFFOLK POLICE RESPOND TO INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENT**

SUFFOLK, VA (August 29, 2020) Suffolk Fire & Rescue and Suffolk Police are currently on the scene of an industrial accident which occurred in the 2000 block of Northgate Commerce Parkway this afternoon, Saturday, August 29, 2020. Emergency Dispatch was notified of the incident at approximately 2:13 p.m.

Emergency crews have confirmed there are two deceased victims. There are additional workers who are unaccounted for at this time with emergency crews searching for those individuals.

The Chesapeake Fire Department and the Virginia Fire Department Technical Rescue Teams are also on the scene assisting.

No additional information is available for release at this time.
