WOMAN ARRESTED FOLLOWING ARSON OF VEHICLE

SUFFOLK, VA (September 5, 2020) The Suffolk Fire Marshal's Office has advised of the arrest of a woman following their investigation of a vehicle arson.

Emergency Communications was contacted on August 10, 2020, at approximately 9:09 a.m. after a vehicle was found in a ditch in the 2700 block of Copeland Avenue. Suffolk Police responded to the scene and found the unoccupied vehicle with fire damage to the interior. The Suffolk Fire Marshal's Office responded to continue the investigation.
