DESIGN PUBLIC MEETING PITCHKETTLE ROAD REALIGNMENT PROJECT

SUFFOLK, VA (September 14, 2020) The City of Suffolk will be holding a public meeting for the Pitchkettle Road Realignment Project (UPC 113126) at Saint Paul Baptist Church, located at 806 Lincoln Avenue, on Thursday September 24, 2020, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

The purpose of the meeting is for the City to display three potential design alternatives to the public and present an opportunity for citizens to provide feedback. City staff will be present and available to answer questions and receive feedback on the project.
