SUFFOLK POLICE INVESTIGATING STABBING INCIDENT

SUFFOLK, Virginia (October 6, 2020) Suffolk Police are investigating an incident that occurred yesterday afternoon, Monday, October 5, 2020, during which an adult male victim sustained multiple stab wounds. Suffolk Police had responded to Sentara Obici Hospital at 2:30 p.m. after the victim had driven himself to that location for treatment of his injuries.

It is unknown at this time the location where the aggravated malicious wounding took place, and the investigation remains ongoing at this time.

The victim, Reginald Dante Flournoy, age 35, of Hampton, was flown by Nightingale to a local hospital for treatment of life-threatening injuries. He is currently listed in stable condition.
