SUFFOLK POLICE AND SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE RESPOND TO VEHICLE VERSUS PEDESTRIAN ACCIDENT

SUFFOLK, VA (October 31, 2020) – Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded to the scene of a vehicle versus a pedestrian accident this afternoon, Saturday, October 31, 2020 in the 200 block of North Main Street. Emergency Communications was notified of the accident at 4:29 p.m.

Following emergency medical assessment and treatment by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel, the injured female was transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries. The vehicle did remain on the scene following the accident. The driver was cited for failure to yield to a pedestrian in a crosswalk.

Two lanes of North Main Street were closed for about 25 minutes due to the accident.
