### **POLICE INVESTIGATING ARMED COMMERCIAL ROBBERY**

SUFFOLK, VA (November 10, 2020) – Suffolk Police are investigating a Commercial Armed Robbery which occurred earlier this morning, Tuesday, November 10, 2020, at Ding Wing, also known as Tammy’s Kitchen, located in the 600 block of East Washington Street. Emergency Communications was notified of the incident at 1:40 a.m.

Upon preliminary investigation, it was determined that two black male subjects entered the business, fired a weapon, and an undetermined amount of cash was taken before fleeing the location. No injuries were reported as a result of the incident. The incident remains under investigation.
