**THREE DISPLACED IN RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE FIRE**

SUFFOLK, VA (March 25, 2021) Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded to the scene of a residential structure fire earlier this morning, Thursday, March 25, 2021, in the 100 block of Greenfield Crescent. Emergency Communications was contacted at 4:19 a.m., and the first units arrived on scene in the Southside Meadows neighborhood at 4:26 a.m.

Battalion Chief William Kessinger advised that first arriving fire units found a one-story residence with light smoke coming from the residence. The occupants had evacuated prior to the arrival of firefighters. The crew entered the residence and found a small fire that was contained to the kitchen area. Three persons have been displaced, including one adult and two juveniles. The fire was called under control at 4:35 a.m. There were no injuries.

Responding units included Battalion 1; Engines 1, 2, and 3; Ladder 3; Rescue 1 and 6; Medic 3; EMS-1; Safety 1; and FM-1. The Fire Marshal's Office will be investigating to determine the cause of the fire.
