UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA (June 16, 2021) Suffolk Police advise that two lanes of travel on Route 58/Portsmouth Boulevard Westbound at the City line have now reopened to through traffic, however, delays still exist in the immediate area.

The third lane of travel will be opening after the resulting debris from the tractor trailer fire are removed from the roadway.

Battalion Chief James Broglin of Suffolk Fire & Rescue advises that the tractor trailer will be hauled to the SPSA Landfill for further investigation as to the cause of the fire.

TRACTOR TRAILER FIRE CLOSSES PORTION OF ROUTE 58 AT CITY LINE

SUFFOLK, VA (June 16, 2021) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue units are currently on the scene of a tractor trailer fire on Route 58/Portsmouth Boulevard Westbound at the City line.

Emergency Communications was contacted at approximately 2:31 p.m. advising of the incident. There are no injuries. Mutual aid is being provided by the Chesapeake Fire Department.

The roadway in the immediate area is anticipated to be shut down for an extended period of time and detours will be put in place.
