SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE AND SUFFOLK POLICE RESPOND TO VEHICLE VERSUS COMMERCIAL BUILDING ACCIDENT

SUFFOLK, VA (September 8, 2021) Suffolk Fire & Rescue and Suffolk Police responded to the scene of a vehicle versus a commercial building accident this morning, Wednesday, September 8, 2021. The accident occurred in the 2300 block of Pruden Boulevard at the NAPA Auto Parts store. Suffolk Emergency Communications was contacted at 11:11 a.m.

The single occupant vehicle was in the parking lot when it struck the building. No injuries were reported.

Suffolk Planning & Community Development Department building officials have been contacted to respond to confirm the structural integrity of the building. No determination has been made at this time.

The incident remains under investigation.
