SHOOTING INTO AN OCCUPIED DWELLING

SUFFOLK, VA (October 2, 2021) The Suffolk Police are currently investigating a shooting into an occupied dwelling incident that occurred in the 1600 block of Freeney Avenue. On October 2, 2021, the Suffolk 911 Center received a call at 4:35 PM of shots being fired in the 1600 block of Freeney Ave. When units arrived they found a residence and a vehicle had been struck by gunfire. There are no injuries reported during this incident.

The investigation remains ongoing at this time, and there is no further information available for release.
