HOUSE IN HOLLAND DESTROYED BY FIRE

SUFFOLK, VA (October 6, 2021) Suffolk Fire & Rescue units are currently on the scene of a residential structure fire in the 6500 block of Holland Road.

Emergency Communications was contacted at 3:43 p.m. advising of the fire in the rural Holland borough. The first units arrived on scene at 3:51 p.m. to find heavy fire showing from the front of the two-story residence, and firefighters began an exterior attack of the fire that extended to the first and second floors. It was confirmed that all of the occupants had safely evacuated prior to their arrival.

The structure has been determined a total loss. It is unknown at this time the total number of those that have been displaced.

A neighboring residence also sustained extensive heat damage to the exterior siding.

There were no injuries. Suffolk Police are also on scene and the roadway in the immediate area will be closed for an extended period of time.

Responding units included Battalion 1; Engines 1, 2, 4, and 7; Tankers 1, 7, and 8; EMS-1, Rescue 1, Ladder 6, and Safety 1.

The Fire Marshal's Office will be handling the investigation to determine the cause of the fire.
