## **LARGE DETACHED RESIDENTIAL GARAGE FIRE ON NANSEMOND PKY.**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (October 17, 2021): Suffolk Fire & Rescue and Suffolk Police responded Sunday afternoon, October 17, 2021, to a reported building fire in the 1400 block of Nansemond Parkway.

Emergency Communications was contacted at 12:57 p.m. and the first unit arrived on scene at 1:03 p.m.

Engine 3, Ladder 3, and Medic 3 arrived to find a large two car detached garage on fire in the back yard of the residence. Suffolk Fire & Rescue units placed three lines into service and was able to prevent the fire from spreading from the well-involved two car garage to near-by structures. The large detached garage sustained heavy fire damage. The main residence sustained heat damage from the garage fire. The fire was under control at 1:20 p.m. No one was displaced by the fire. No injuries to firefighters or civilians.

The fire remains under investigation by the Suffolk Fire Marshal's Office.

Responding units included Battalion 1, Battalion 2, Engine 3, Engine 1, Engine 26, Ladder 3, Medic 3, Rescue 1, EMS-1, Safety 1, and Fire Marshal 7.
