UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA (January 11, 2022) Suffolk Police advise they have made an arrest in the December 28, 2021 shooting incident in the 400 block of Wilson Street. Police have arrested a 17 year old juvenile on charges of Shooting from Occupied Vehicle, Shooting into Occupied Dwelling, Possession of Firearm by Juvenile, Use or Display of Firearm in Commission of Felony, Reckless Handling of Firearm, Destruction of Property, Discharge Firearm in Public Place, and Shooting In/Across Road or In Street.

The juvenile is in custody and will be transferred to Chesapeake Juvenile Services.

The investigation remains ongoing at this time, and there is no further information available for release. SHOOTING INVESTIGATION

SUFFOLK, VA

On December 28, 2021 at 1821 hours, Suffolk Police responded to the 400 block of Wilson Street for a report of gunshots fired. Officers arrived and located a juvenile male victim and an adult male suffering minor gunshot wounds. The victims received treatment from Suffolk Fire and Rescue personnel and were transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries. This is an active investigation and there is no suspect information available at this time.
