**SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE RESPOND TO RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE FIRE –
NANSEMOND PARKWAY**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (February 16, 2022) Suffolk Fire & Rescue are on the scene of a residential structure fire today, Wednesday, February 16, 2022, in the 1100 block of Nansemond Parkway in the Magnolia Lake Mobile Home Park. Emergency Communications was contacted at 11:29 a.m.

Fire Chief Michael Barakey advised the first unit arrived on the scene at 11:36 a.m. for the incident involving a bedroom fire in a trailer home. The occupants of the home were out of the residence prior to Fire Department arrival. The fire was marked under control at 11:44 a.m. The two occupants suffered minor injuries, were evaluated at the scene, and refused medical transport. It is unknown at this time if the residents will be displaced.

Responding units included Engine 3, Ladder 3, Medic 3, EMS 2, Rescue 1, Battalion 1, Engine 1, Engine 6, Safety 1, Battalion 3, Fire Marshal 6, Fire Marshal 7, and Suffolk Police.

The cause of the fire remains under investigation.
