UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA (February 17, 2022) Westbound Route 58 at Pruden Boulevard will have one lane closed today, Thursday, February 17, 2022, starting at 9:30 a.m. as crews work to remove the box container left in the median after yesterday's accident at this location. It is estimated that the operation will take approximately four hours and will impact traffic due to the lane closure. Both lanes may be closed for periods of time as well during the work period.

Suffolk Police and Public Works crews will be on site to assist with traffic control.

The driver of the vehicle had minor injuries and was assessed and released at the scene by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel.

The roadway at this location will be closed for an undetermined amount of time.
