**SUFFOLK POLICE INVESTIGATE COMMERCIAL BURGLARY**

SUFFOLK, VA (February 23, 2022) On Tuesday, February 22, 2022 at 3:31 a.m., Officers responded to an alarm call in the 5900 block of Godwin Boulevard. When Officers arrived at the D & P Quick Stop, they observed the front glass door of the business was broken.

A review of the security camera showed a Black male, heavy build, wearing a red Washington Capitals hoodie, white face mask, black gloves on his left hand, and a gray glove on his right hand with black pants. The suspect approached the store on foot then broke the glass by throwing a brick through the front door. The suspect was inside the store for less than 2 minutes and took several hundreds of dollars' worth of cigarettes before leaving the scene.

The investigation remains ongoing at this time, and there is no further information available for release.
