UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA (March 21, 2022) Suffolk Fire Marshal Chris Cornwell advised that the Suffolk Fire Marshal's Office has arrested a juvenile male student who remains in custody on a charge of threatening to bomb the school. Petitions are pending.

The all clear has been given and students have returned to the classrooms. No threat was found after a search of the school by the Fire Marshal's Office.

The incident remains under investigation.

LAKELAND HIGH SCHOOL EVACUATED DUE TO REPORT OF BOMB THREAT

SUFFOLK, VA (March 21, 2022) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue are on the scene of a report of a bomb threat at Lakeland High School today, Monday, March 21, 2022. Emergency Communications was notified of the incident by a school administrator at 10:54 a.m.

The school has been evacuated.

The incident remains under investigation at this time.
