375 KENYON RD. EVACUATED DUE TO REPORT OF BOMB THREAT

SUFFOLK, VA (March 27, 2022) Suffolk Fire and Rescue, Suffolk Police, and the Virginia State Police responded to the scene for a reported bomb threat at California Cartage Co. today, Sunday, March 27, 2022. The initial threat was received by Newport News City Dispatch who then notified Suffolk Emergency Communications at 3:53 p.m. The unknown caller stated that multiple devices were set to detonate at 5:00 p.m. Apparatus that responded to the incident included Battalion 1, Engine 4, Safety 1, Fire Marshal 7, Fire Marshal 1, and the Virginia State Police Area 5 K-9 Division.

The facility was evacuated until cleared by the Virginia State Police K-9 Division, at which time the occupants were allowed to return and the building was turned back over to management.

The incident remains under investigation at this time.
