SUFFOLK, VA (March 31, 2022) Suffolk Fire & Rescue advise the leak has been secured. All lanes of traffic reopened around 11:40 a.m.

SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE AND SUFFOLK POLICE ON SCENE OF GAS LEAK

SUFFOLK, VA (March 31, 2022) Suffolk Fire & Rescue and Suffolk Police are on the scene of a gas leak in the 1500 block of Holland Road/Route 58 today, Thursday March 31, 2022. Emergency Communications was notified of the incident at 8:59 a.m. One lane of traffic is currently open in each direction which is impacting traffic flow at this time.

Battalion Chief Demitri Wilson reported that a construction crew struck a 1 ½ inch gas line and that Virginia Natural Gas is in route to the secure the leak. There have been no evacuations of residents or businesses due to the location of the leak. No injuries were reported.

An estimate on the repair time is unknown at this time.
