CREWS RESPONDED TO COMMERCIAL STRUCTURE FIRE IN COLD STORAGE FACILITY

SUFFOLK, Virginia (April 26,2022): Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded Monday evening, April 25, 2022, to a reported commercial structure fire in the 200 block of Culloden Street.

Emergency Communications was contacted at 6:28 p.m. and fire crews arrived at 6:32 p.m.

Crews arrived to find a large commercial structure that had been evacuated upon their arrival. Once inside the structure, firefighters found fire in the cooking ventilation system. Firefighters were able to extinguish the fire quickly. The fire was under control at 6:47 p.m.

No injuries to firefighters. The fire is under investigation by the Suffolk Department of Fire & Rescue Fire Marshal's Office.

Responding units included Battalion 1, Engine 1, Engine 2, Engine 3, Ladder 3, Ladder 6, Medic 3, EMS-1, Safety 1, and Fire Marshal 7.
