CREWS RESPOND TO RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE FIRE: FOUR DISPLACED

SUFFOLK, VA (April 26, 2022) Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded to the 1000 block of Holland Road for a residential structure fire on Tuesday evening. Emergency Communications dispatched the incident at 9:20 p.m. with the first units arriving on scene at 9:25.

First crews on scene arrived to find a fire in the rear of the structure, with all occupants safely out of the building. An aggressive interior fire attack occurred and the fire was marked under control at 9:46 p.m. Suffolk Police provided traffic control. No injuries reported by firefighters or occupants. The home sustained smoke and fire damage, and The American Red Cross is assisting the displaced occupants. The Fire Marshal's Office is investigating the cause and origin of the fire.

Responding units included Battalion 1, EMS 1, Engine 1, Engine 2, Engine 4, Ladder 3, Medic 1, Rescue 1, Safety 1 and Fire Marshal's Office.
