POLICE INVESTIGATING COMMERCIAL ARMED ROBBERY

SUFFOLK, Virginia (February 28, 2017) Suffolk Police are investigating an armed robbery that occurred late Monday evening, February 27, 2017, at Domino's Pizza located in the 500 block of East Constance Road in downtown Suffolk.

Emergency Communications was made aware of the incident at 9:45 p.m.

Upon preliminary investigation it was found that an unknown adult black male entered the business, displayed a firearm and demanded money. The suspect fled on foot with an undetermined amount of currency.

The subject is further described as between 20 and 40 years of age, approximately 6' tall with an average to medium build, a short stubble mustache, and wearing gray sweat pants, gray hoodie, black ski mask and black gloves.

No one was injured during the incident.

Several surveillance video photos accompany this release.

Anyone with information is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in

court. Citizens can also utilize TipSoft to anonymously submit crime-related tips through the Web, a text message, or from any Android or iPhone mobile device with the TipSubmit mobile app. Tips can be submitted by visiting www.suffolkva.us/crimelinetips, or by texting the word “**CRIMES**” (274637) with the keyword **SPDVATIP**. TipSoft also supports users’ ability to submit videos or photos using the TipSoft mobile app. If information leads to an arrest, the caller or “tipster” could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
