POLICE INVESTIGATING AUTO-PEDESTRIAN ACCIDENT

SUFFOLK, Virginia (October 25, 2016) – The Suffolk Police Department is currently investigating an accident involving a passenger vehicle that struck a pedestrian. The driver of the vehicle remained on the scene.

Emergency Communications was notified of the accident at 8:38 p.m. Upon preliminary investigation it was found that the vehicle was traveling eastbound on Portsmouth Boulevard/Route 58 just past the intersection of Suburban Drive when an adult male was struck while attempting to cross the roadway.

The victim received emergency medical assessment and treatment by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel and was ground transported to the Hampton Roads Regional Airport on Route 58, where he was then airlifted by Nightingale to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital. His injuries are considered serious.

The investigation remains ongoing at this time.
