POLICE INVESTIGATING CRASH OF STOLEN VEHICLE

SUFFOLK, Virginia (September 22, 2016) Suffolk Police are currently investigating an accident involving a stolen vehicle.

At approximately 1:46 p.m. Suffolk Police received information of a possible stolen vehicle that was traveling westbound on Route 58 into the City of Suffolk. Officers observed the Dodge Nitro taking the Pitchkettle Road exit. The vehicle then continued onto Kings Fork Road where it disregarded a red light at the intersection of Pruden Boulevard/Route 460 and struck a Jeep Wrangler, causing minor damage to the Jeep.

Immediately following the accident all four occupants of the Dodge Nitro fled the vehicle on foot. Officers were able to apprehend the three males and one female approximately 100 yards from the accident scene.

Suffolk Fire & Rescue also responded and there were no injuries.

The vehicle was found to have been stolen from Newport News. The investigation remains ongoing at this time.
