POLICE INVESTIGATING AUTO-PEDESTRIAN ACCIDENT

SUFFOLK, Virginia (March 24, 2016) – The Suffolk Police Department is investigating a two vehicle accident that also involved a pedestrian that occurred this evening at the intersection of East Washington Street and Hollywood Avenue in downtown Suffolk.

Emergency Communications was made aware of the accident at 10:24 p.m. Upon preliminary investigation it was found that an adult male, age 20, was struck by an SUV as he was outside of his disabled vehicle pushing it from the roadway on East Washington Street onto Hollywood Avenue. The vehicle he was pushing was also struck by the SUV that was traveling west on East Washington Street. The driver of the SUV remained on the scene.

The male driver that had been struck and his two passengers, a female age 24 and a female age 43, received emergency medical assessment and treatment by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel and all were ground transported to Sentara Obici Hospital for treatment of non-life threatening injuries.

The accident remains under investigation.
