**ARRESTS MADE IN THEFTS FROM VEHICLES**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (August 2, 2015) Suffolk Police advise that two individuals have been arrested following the investigation into a rash of thefts from vehicles from 18 different locations in the Lakeside neighborhood.

Multiple reports were received of unknown subjects tampering with vehicles in the Lakeside community between July 31<sup>st</sup> and August 1<sup>st</sup>, with citizens reporting various items stolen from their vehicles.

Following their investigation Suffolk Police arrested Daylan Malik Wilkins, age 18, of Suffolk, and Juwon O'Shea Allen, age 19, also of Suffolk. They were each charged with 20 counts of Entering the Property of Another, Grand Larceny, Conspiracy to Commit Grand Larceny and 4 counts of Petit Larceny. They are both currently being held without bond at Western Tidewater Regional Jail.
