SUFFOLK POLICE MAKE ARRESTS IN ARMED RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY INCIDENT

SUFFOLK, Virginia (June 9, 2015) Suffolk Police arrested several individuals involved in an Armed Residential Burglary that occurred earlier this morning. Shortly before 2:00 a.m., Officers responded to a reported Breaking & Entering in progress in the 100 block of Torrington Court in the Governor's Pointe neighborhood in northern Suffolk.

A suspicious vehicle was observed leaving the area and a traffic stop was initiated. Four subjects were detained, and as a result of the investigation the following individuals have been arrested and charged with Armed Residential Burglary and Conspiracy to Commit Armed Burglary:

- Jordan Chase Alvarez, age 21, of Hampton
- Curtis Childs, age 24, of Newport News
- Anthony Lamont Scott-McNeill, age 22, of Newport News

The three subjects are currently being held without bond at WTRJ. The fourth subject has not been charged. The investigation is ongoing.
