SINGLE VEHICLE ACCIDENT ROUTE 460

SUFFOLK, Virginia (June 13, 2015) Suffolk Police are currently on the scene of a single vehicle accident that occurred in the 4400 block of westbound Pruden Boulevard/Route 460.

Emergency Communications received the call at 8:52 a.m. advising of the accident involving a Chevrolet Monte Carlo. Upon preliminary investigation it was found that the vehicle left the roadway, glanced off a power pole and came to rest on its roof in a ditch.

Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel provided emergency medical assessment to the three males that were in the vehicle, who sustained non-life threatening injuries that did not require medical transport.

Both westbound lanes were closed for a period of time immediately following the accident, and then one eastbound lane was closed as traffic was alternated to allow the continued flow of traffic. All lanes reopened at 10:05 a.m.

The driver, Eric Billeter, age 18, of Chester, Virginia, was issued a summons for Reckless Driving and Failure to Maintain Control.
