### SUFFOLK POLICE SEEK PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE IN CHECK FRAUD INCIDENT

SUFFOLK, VA (May 27, 2015) Suffolk Police are seeking the public's assistance in identifying a male suspect involved in a check fraud incident committed at the Navy Federal Credit Union in Norfolk. The incident occurred on May 9, 2015 at approximately 12:13 A.M. The victim resides in Suffolk and the victim's checks were stolen during a prior event.

Video surveillance captured images of the suspect at this location.

Anyone with information is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-LOCK-U-UP<sup>SM</sup>. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. Citizens can also utilize TipSoft to anonymously submit crime-related tips through the Web, a text message, or from any Android or iPhone mobile device with the TipSubmit mobile app. Tips can be submitted by visiting [www.suffolkva.us/crimelinetips](http://www.suffolkva.us/crimelinetips), or by texting the word "**CRIMES**" (274637) with the keyword **SPDVATIP**. TipSoft also supports users' ability to submit videos or photos using the TipSoft mobile app. If information leads to an arrest, the caller or "tipster" could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
