**APARTMENT FIRE DISPLACES FAMILY**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (June 14, 2014) Suffolk Fire & Rescue and the Suffolk Police Department responded earlier this evening to an apartment fire at Cypress Manor Apartments in the 50 block of Stacey Drive.

Emergency Communications received the call at 7:39 p.m. and units were on scene at 7:43 p.m. The fire originated in the kitchen of the apartment. No residents were home when rescue units arrived. The fire was under control at 7:58 p.m.

Three adults and three children in the apartment have been displaced and will be assisted by the American Red Cross. There were no injuries.

Engines 1, 2 and 3, Ladders 3 and 6, Rescue 1, Battalion 1, EMS 1 and Medic 3 responded to the fire.

The Fire Marshal's Office is investigating the cause of the fire.
