SUFFOLK, VA (May 27, 2014) East Washington Street between Pinner Street and North Main Street is currently closed as Suffolk Fire & Rescue and Suffolk Police are on the scene of an incident in the 100 block of East Washington Street. Emergency Communications received a call at 3:04 p.m. in relation to an electrical burning smell on the second floor of Suffolk Antiques.
