### TWO ALARM BLAZE AT APARTMENT COMPLEX

SUFFOLK, VA (September 2, 2014) Suffolk Fire & Rescue and Suffolk Police are currently on the scene of a two alarm fire at Wilson Pines Apartments, located in the 2500 block of East Washington Street in downtown Suffolk.

Emergency Communications received the call at 7:36 p.m. and the first units were on scene at 7:42 p.m. The fire is confined to Building D at the complex and spread to two apartment units and a breezeway. There have been no reported injuries.

The 2500 block of East Washington Street was closed for a period of time but now one lane is open.

The fire was upgraded to a two alarm blaze. Responding units include Engine 3, Rescue 6, Medic 1 A, Engine 2, Battalion 1, Engine 1, EMS 1, Ladder 6, Rescue 1, Ladder 5, Medic 6A, Rehab 6, Engine 6, Engine 4 and Battalion 2.

It is unknown at this time how many families have been displaced. An updated release will be sent as soon as this information is available.
