## **SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE RESPOND TO STRUCTURE FIRE**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (August 11, 2014) Suffolk Fire & Rescue and Suffolk Police responded to a structure fire in the 7100 block of Crittenden Road this morning. Emergency Dispatch received a call about the incident at 9:51 a.m. The first unit arrived on the scene at 9:58 a.m.

The fire was in the second story addition over the attached garage of the unoccupied home. The fire did not spread into the living quarters of the home. The fire was marked under control at 10:22 a.m. There were no injuries reported.

Chuckatuck Volunteer Fire Engine 29, Car 109, Tanker 9, Medic 9A, Engine 6, Ladder 5, Ladder 6, EMS 1, Battalion 2, and Fire Marshal 4 responded to the fire.

The cause of the fire is currently under investigation by the Suffolk Fire Marshal's Office.
