### **SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE BATTLE HOUSE FIRE**

SUFFOLK, VA (February 3, 2014) Suffolk Fire & Rescue and Suffolk Police responded to a structure fire in the 900 block of East Washington Street in downtown Suffolk this evening. The call came in at 7:04 p.m. and units arrived on scene at 7:09 p.m.

Engines 2 and 3, Ladder 3, Rescue 1, Medic 6A, EMS 1, Medic 2A, and Battalion 1 responded to the scene.

The 2-story wood frame structure was converted into two apartments, and the fire occurred in the second floor apartment. The ground floor apartment was vacant. Two adults have been displaced. A male resident was ground transported to Sentara Obici Hospital with non-life threatening injuries. No firefighters were injured in the fire.

The Fire Marshal's Office is investigating the cause of the fire.
