### **SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE WORK STRUCTURE FIRE**

SUFFOLK, VA (February 7, 2014) Suffolk Fire and Rescue and Suffolk Police responded to a structure fire in the 200 block of Central Avenue following a call to Dispatchers at 6:52 p.m. this evening.

Fire & Rescue personnel arrived on the scene at 6:58 p.m. and found a two story residential apartment unit with light smoke showing upon arrival. The fire had run up the side of the exterior of the house and under the siding and between the studs. The fire was declared under control at 7:15 p.m.

The structure sustained approximately \$2000 worth of damage. None of the residents were displaced as a result of the fire. There were no reported injuries. The incident remains under investigation by the Suffolk Fire Marshal's Office.

Battalion 1, Engine 1, Engine 2, Rescue 1, EMS 1, Ladder 3, and Medic 3 responded to the incident.
