### **TWO VEHICLE ACCIDENT CLOSES PORTION OF ROUTE 460**

SUFFOLK, VA (June 9, 2015) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel were on the scene earlier this afternoon of a two vehicle accident that closed three lanes of eastbound and westbound traffic in the 2400 block of Pruden Boulevard/Route 460 near Lida Avenue. Traffic was alternated with the remaining open lane.

Emergency Communications received the initial call at 1:48 p.m. advising of the accident involving a Toyota Avalon and a Dodge Ram 1500.

Suffolk Fire & Rescue and EMS crews provided emergency medical assessment at the scene. The adult female driver of the Toyota Avalon was ground transported to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital with non-life threatening injuries, and the adult female driver of the Dodge Ram 1500 was ground transported to Sentara Obici Hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

All lanes of travel reopened at 2:55 p.m. The cause of the accident is under investigation.
