EMERGENCY CREWS RESPOND TO SINGLE VEHICLE ACCIDENT

SUFFOLK, VA (June 19, 2014) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded to the scene of a single vehicle accident this afternoon which required the extrication of the driver.

Emergency Communications received the call at 3:35 p.m. advising of the accident at Godwin Boulevard and Harrell Drive.

Upon preliminary investigation it was determined that the 58-year-old male driver was traveling westbound on Godwin Boulevard when he left the roadway and crashed into the ditch. Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel extricated him from the Chrysler 300 and he was ground transported to Sentara Obici Hospital where he was later airlifted to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital for treatment of what are believed to be non-life threatening injuries.

The roadway was briefly closed to allow the tow truck to remove the vehicle. The cause of the accident is under investigation.
